Education Initiatives

Hidayat Jumani welfare trust's aims to provide quality education to under privileged communities through its various educational projects. The major accomplishment in the education sector is shown in below.

- Established scholarship programs for underprivileged students through Sukkur IBA University, providing financial support for deserving students.
- Paid School, College, University, and Semester Fees for deserving students that are mostly from District Khairpur Mir's and adjacent villages.
- Trust Paid Salaries for 13 School teachers that are deputed in different government schools such as GBH School Bakhar Kanasira, GBP School Bakhar Kanasira, GGP School Bakhar Kanasira & GBH School Jurial Shar.

Healthcare Initiatives

Hidayat Jumani welfare trust's aims to provide free health service to the poor and needy patients and facilitate people and help them to get rid of the diseases. The major accomplishment in the health sector are shown in below.

- Provided Financial Assistance for the medical treatment of deserving patients.
- Donates Rs. 100,000 per month to Red Crescent Hospital on account of provision of Oxygen gas for the patients.

- Donates Rs. 32,500 per month to Fatimid Foundation on account of 5 Thalassemia patients for their medical treatment.
- Provided free of cost ambulance service for immediate assistance to patient in case of any emergency throughout khairpur.

Social Welfare Initiatives:


- During the holy month of Ramadan, 2,225 ration packets & 750 Cloths were distributed to underprivileged households.
- Makes a monthly donation of Rs. 65,000 to SOS Children village Khairpur on account Stationery, Ration & Medicine for their Children.
- Dowry Items were given to deserving persons so that they could be able to manage the marriage of daughters/sisters.
- Gave hundreds of impoverished individual's financial assistance in the form of Zakat donation.
