Our food aid programs have supported hundreds of families, ensuring that they have enough to eat during tough times.

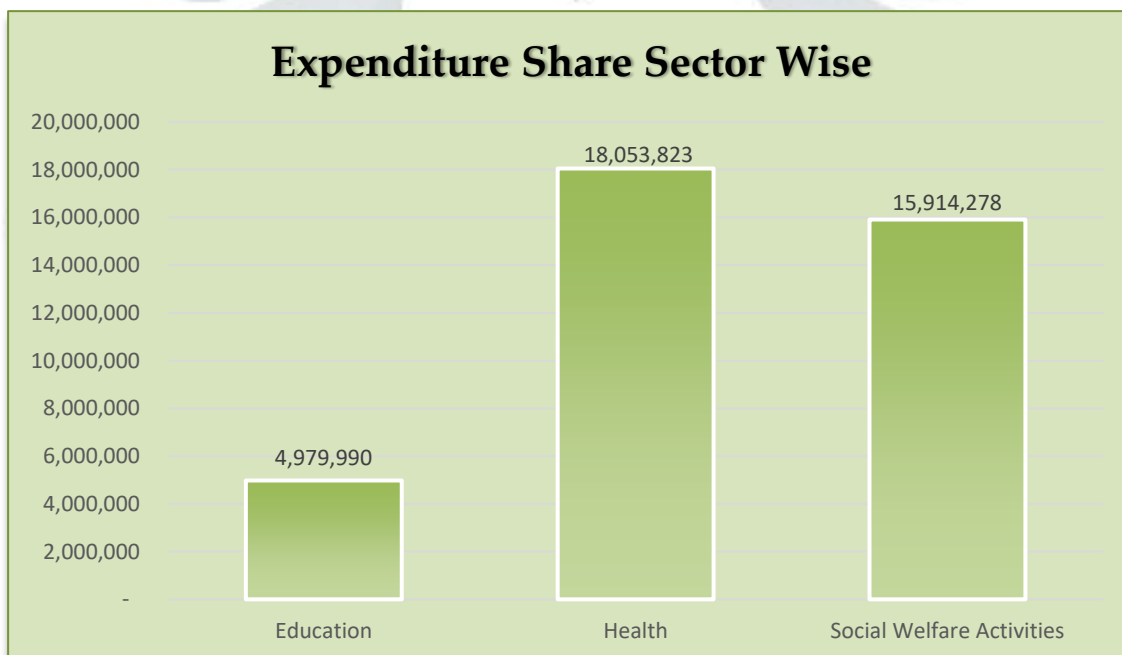
